You can select multiple search criteria and then click on **Apply** to display results.

- 1 Search by code**
Search for the official Resolution number that you find on the printed document or you can search for the internal code constructed in the following way:
WCC/GA Year Res/Rec Number e.g. *WCC 2008 Rec 081*
You can also search by code using the official code: e.g. *3.081*
- 2 Search by type**
Search for either Resolution or Recommendation
- 3 Search by title**
Search for the official Resolution title by using a word or phrase contained in the title. E.g. *Species Survival Commission*
- 4 Search by conference**
Search for Resolutions adopted during a specific Congress or General Assembly. Example: if you select *2008 Barcelona* and *1990 Perth*, all Resolutions and Recommendations adopted in Barcelona and all Resolutions and Recommendations adopted in Perth will be displayed.
