2. Resolution on the International Biological Programme

In the light of reports on the current preparations for an International Biological Programme, the 8th General Assembly of IUCN meeting at Nairobi in 1963 notes with approval the role proposed for the Union in the Programme and the financial support planned for it by UNESCO, expresses satisfaction at the progress already made by the subcommission on conservation and resolves to give all practicable support to the further development of the International Biological Programme in the ecological study and conservation of natural and semi-natural areas.
