3. Resolution on the African Charter for Protection and Conservation of Nature

Having taken note of the African Charter for the Protection and Conservation of Nature agreed by the representatives of African States assembled at Dar es Salaam for the 18th Session of CCTA in February 1963 and believing this declaration of principles to constitute an important step in the development, throughout Africa, of full public awareness of the importance of the problems involved, the 8th General Assembly of IUCN meeting at Nairobi in 1963 fully endorses the African Charter which bears such clear witness to the growing awareness of the legitimate demands of nature conservation.
