

20. Resolution on dam on Hluhluwe River in NATAL

Whereas the construction of the dam on the Hluhluwe River in Zululand is likely to result in some undesirable changes to the environment both in the Hluhluwe Game Reserve and the St. Lucia Lake Reserve with its delicately balanced estuarine fauna, its magnificent bird breeding colonies, its great scientific interest and its tourist potential, the 8th General Assembly of IUCN meeting at Nairobi in 1963 urges the Government of the Republic of South Africa to undertake a comprehensive ecological survey before irrevocable changes in these regions are allowed to take place.
