

22. Resolution on Mount Loma in SIERRA LEONE

Whereas Mount Loma, in Sierra Leone, contains a unique flora and an abundant fauna and whereas the mountain massif constitutes a refuge for wildlife, a reservoir for the production of seeds of trees of great economic value and a great tourist attraction; the 8th General Assembly of IUCN meeting at Nairobi in 1963 congratulates the Government of Sierra Leone for having classed this region as a Forest Reserve and hopes that the Reserve will as soon as possible be classified with the status of an integral nature reserve or a National Park.
