

24. Resolution on a World Conference on the survival of animals and plants threatened with extinction

Whereas many animal and plant species and sub-species are at present threatened with extinction, the 8th General Assembly of IUCN meeting at Nairobi in 1963 recommends that IUCN through its Survival Service Commission in collaboration with the World Wildlife Fund, the International Council for Bird Preservation, the Fauna Preservation Society, the International Union of Directors of Zoological Gardens, Directors of Botanical Gardens and other appropriate organisations, should call for a conference in 1965, to review the status of such animals and plants and to consider the general and particular steps to be taken to save them from extinction and to prevent other species and sub-species from becoming so threatened.
