28. Resolution on spotted cats

Whereas the present fashion in wearing apparel made from the skins of jaguars, leopards, serval cats, cheetahs and other spotted cats is a threat to the continued existence of these kinds of animals, the 8th General Assembly of IUCN meeting at Nairobi in 1963 calls upon all governments to introduce immediate control to restrict the export and import of the skins of these animals in either processed or unprocessed forms.
