19.27 Cooperation to Establish "Green Jobs"

RECOGNIZING the substantial potential of innovative technology and some traditional crafts to reduce the negative impacts which industry has on the global environment;

The General Assembly of IUCN - The World Conservation Union, at its 19th Session in Buenos Aires, Argentina, 17-26 January 1994:

- 1. ENCOURAGES State members to assist the development of industries in their countries which are beneficial to the environment, or which at least reduce negative impacts upon it;
- 2. ENCOURAGES bilateral and multilateral international organizations to support States to facilitate "greening" of industry and to create "green jobs", in collaboration with business, industry, trade unions and commercial sectors;
- 3. REQUESTS the United Nations Development Programme to cooperate with other funding agencies, with the UN Commission on Sustainable Development and with bodies representative of business, industry, trade unions and commerce in the development of a coordinated strategy for the "greening" of industry and the creation of "green jobs".
