19.12 Cooperation with International Organizations in Africa

NOTING the conclusions of the meeting of IUCN members and partners in Western Africa, held in Bamako, Mali, 1-3 September 1993; RECOGNIZING the importance of international cooperation to address the pressing environmental problems in Africa;

The General Assembly of IUCN - The World Conservation Union, at its 19th Session in Buenos Aires, Argentina, 17-26 January 1994:

REQUESTS the Director General to pursue close working relationships with intergovernmental organizations in Africa, such as the Permanent Inter-State Committee for Drought Control in the Sahel (CILSS), the Southern African Development Community (SADC) and other similar bodies, with the objective of developing with them programmes on conservation and sustainable development.
