700 West African giraffes, population estimate

9,000 tree seedlings produced, planted or distributed

53,000€ of micro-credits distributed to poor women

ANTONGIL CONSERVATION

3 births of red-ruffed lemurs

CHEETAH CONSERVATION FUND

General data:

782 scat samples of 12 different species collected
103 cheetahs are taken care of, 71 of which are in Somaliland (SLD)
15 of 26 young cheetahs seized in SLD survived
168 herding dogs protect farms
68 puppies are in training
+16,000 schoolchildren have been educated
435 professionals have been trained



PROYECTO MONO ARANA = CAPARO

4 guards patrolling daily
54 brown spider-monkeys observed
8,700 tree seedlings produced
4 hunters' hides destroyed
15 natural water points identified
5 educational fences built

PROYECTO EREMITA

169 northern bald ibises counted: 82 ♂, 78 ♀, 9 undetermined
50 ibises released: 23 ♂, 9 ♀, 18 ongoing
21 breeding pairs, 17 of which are breeding
26 births and chicks fledged
30 deaths including 13 adults, 15 electrocutions



PROGRAM KONSERVASI HARIMAU SUMATERA



Data related to the support of the Bioparc in 2021 :

7 Sumatran tigers identified
881 km of patrols conducted
63 Sumatran tiger sightings recorded
2 wildlife water wells maintained
61 participants in a management workshop in the BTNP

SNOW LEOPARD TRUST

General data:

13th edition of the ecological survey - 210 paid rangers
Estimated population between 806 and 1127 snow leopards
19,923 km travelled of which 6,794 km on foot
1 ungulate predated every 8 days (ibex, goats, argali)
139 women made 10,000 objects to be valued
15,000 km² protected by the communities



SOPTOM



General data:

18,000 deregistered turtles seized in 2018
2,000 handed over to the SOPTOM

Data related to the support of the Bioparc in 2021 :

500 turtles to be released in a 1st trial:
- 225 ♂ and 275 ♀ between 7 and 23 years old
- 40 will be fitted with transmitters

OKAPI CONSERVATION PROJECT

General data:

70,000 trees for planting have been distributed to villagers
700 farmers participating in the agroforestry program
370 vegetable gardens developed to support 400 families
220 primary school students planted 494 trees
253 guards including 59 new guards, 9 women & 6 Mbuti
20 minimum days of patrols per month
120 beds sent to 20 health centers, for maternity services in 2 provinces, delivered in 20...
44,000 patients received at the clinic
+15,000 people participated in World Okapi Day
200 women are supported through groups

Follow-up + examination at 78 and 86 days

2254 : 1 pair = 1 young fledged "HORTENSE"

2356 : 1 pair = 1 young fledged "BRODI"



SAVE THE RHINO INTERNATIONAL & SAVE THE RHINO TRUST



General data:

0 rhinos poached

8 rangers tracked the rhino population and walked over 2000 km

+ 4,000 confirmed rhino sightings

58 rangers trained to use digital tools for data collection

250 players at a football tournament for World Rhino Day + 1000 spectators

13 camps for rangers on patrol improved

ASOCIACION ARMONIA CIVIL

General data:

1,160 red-fronted macaws counted

159 nests on 46 cliffs and 8 palm trees

62 children reached during one day

10 artificial nests installed on the cliff

Goat-free" enclosure at the foot of the cliff



NATURE EN OCCITANIE



General data:

48 Egyptian vultures identified via photo traps

9 GPS tags installed since 2015

RED PANDA NETWORK

General data:

60 communities involved in monitoring, 81 forest guardians & 1,272 km of patrols

17 new monitoring areas

37 red panda furs seized

156 students awarded scholarships

1,600 students participated in IRPD

80,000 people reached through radio broadcasts



Impact of the Nature Projects in 2021

GREVY'S ZEBRA TRUST



General data:

5,000 bales of hay dropped in 129 days for 800 Grevy's zebras
1,381 foot patrols covering 13,743 km to monitor and protect
2,192 direct observations of Grevy's zebras
78 awareness meetings with 2,445 people
1,163 Dignity packs distributed with 4 sanitary towels
893 girls received these packs, 15 different schools
8 new restoration sites established, 243 hectares
200 half-moons created, 660 people mobilised to remove an invasive species, *Acacia reficiens*, and build the half-moons

CONSERVATOIRE D'ESPACES NATURELS PACA

General data:

28 known breeding Egyptian vultures out of 38 recorded
19 territorial pairs, including 18 breeders
15 producers for 18 ringed fledglings
+ 15 individuals not in the nest and immature via photo traps (plots)



ASSOCIATION FRANCAISE DES PARCS ZOOLOGIQUES



General data:

100 000€ donated to 20 programs in 16 countries on 4 continents including 4 in favor of French wildlife

COMMITTEE AGAINST BIRD SLAUGHTER

General data:

13 intervention countries, 132 volunteers
26 camps organized in 7 countries
6,151 traps, 255 nets & 244 lures seized
268 poachers arrested
+2,400 birds released
